MANASTIRINE

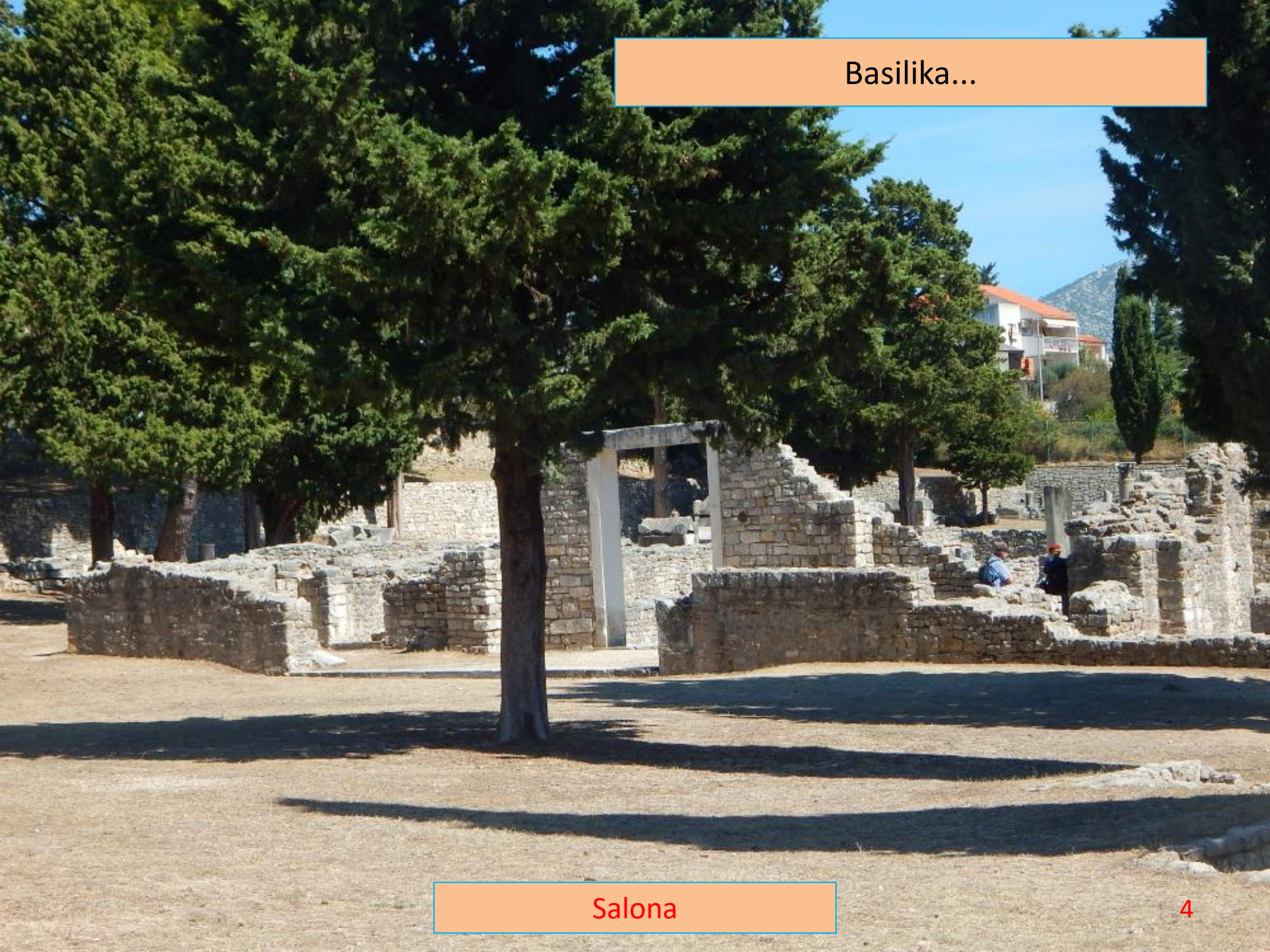
The remains of the basilica and the remains of Manastirine constitute the most important Early Christian complex in Salona, situated outside the town. In the northeastern part of the site remains have been found originating from the 3rd and 4th centuries AD. Starting with the 3rd century AD, when the city of Salona was a Roman legionary station, in the 4th century AD a Roman legionary station was built in the area of Manastirine, an important site for the Roman army. The remains of the basilica and the remains of Manastirine are the most important archaeological remains in Salona.

The first Christian burial in Salona to have taken place at the necropolis was the one of the Roman legionary and martyr Domitian, who had come to Salona from the Roman city of Anagath. He was executed at the amphitheatre of Salona in the 107th or 108th AD. During Domitian's last moments of Christian Domitian's body was deposited in a vaulted tomb, around which the Roman Christian necropolis was built.

At the end of the 4th century a small square building was erected, the Manastirine Chapel 1, containing the tomb of Domitian and his successors in the Roman legionary camp. Simultaneously with the chapel, the adjacent manastirine, which was erected, accommodating the graves and burials of more affluent Christians. The Manastirine
